

Tests of Cognitive Abilities Materials Grants

The Woodcock-Muñoz Foundation is sponsoring a number of instructional materials grants to school, clinical, and counseling psychology programs. The purpose of the grants is to encourage the development of model courses in contemporary cognitive abilities assessment. The Woodcock-Muñoz Foundation will purchase and provide each awarded program with fifteen copies of the *WJ III Tests of Cognitive Abilities* and *Diagnostic Supplement to the Tests of Cognitive Abilities* for training purposes.

To apply for a grant, a university training program must submit a letter of intent and a proposed course syllabus. The letter of intent should describe your training program and your proposed approach to teaching theory and practice in contemporary cognitive ability assessment. The proposed course syllabus must demonstrate that you will use the awarded materials to comprise at least 35% of instructional content, practice requirements, scoring and interpretive documentation, and course evaluation criteria (or the equivalent of one semester credit).
