The [WMF Human Cognitive Abilities \(HCA\) archive project](#) was updated recently with the addition of 22 data sets, according to Kevin McGrew, Woodcock-Muñoz Foundation (WMF) Research Director. Dr. McGrew directs the WMF HCA project, which supports continuing research using the original data sets associated with John B. Carroll's systematic organization and integration of research into the structure of human cognitive abilities.
