

## The WMF Press® Announces Publication of the Woodcock-Johnson International Edition II

*June 23, 2010 Brno, Czech Republic*

This is an historic date for the Woodcock-Johnson International Edition (WJ IE). Dr. Anton Furman, WJ IE Project Coordinator, has officially introduced the second edition of the WJ IE, the *Woodcock-Johnson International Edition II* (WJ IE II), to a group of professional examiners in Teplice, Czech Republic.

The WJ IE II is a translation-adaptation of several tests from the *Woodcock-Johnson III Tests of Cognitive Abilities* (WJ III COG; Woodcock, McGrew, & Mather, 2001, 2007) and the *Diagnostic Supplement to the WJ III Tests of Cognitive Abilities* (Woodcock, McGrew, Mather, & Schrank, 2003, 2007).

The WJ IE II has many new features. Based on translation and data-collection efforts in the Czech Republic, the Concept Formation test has been added to the battery.

With the addition of Concept Formation, the WJ IE II provides a better representation of CHC theory and is more closely aligned with the factor structure of the WJ III COG.

A new intra-cognitive variation procedure, based on test-level variations, allows greater sensitivity to variations among test scores to provide greater interpretive-level information.

The new *Woodcock-Johnson International Edition II Compuscore and Profiles Program* is enhanced by the capability to save data and records and to produce profile reports. To qualified users, the program is downloadable from the Woodcock-Muñoz Foundation website.
